- Tables should be numbered with the captions placed at the top.
- All equations should be centred and the number flushed with the right margin in parenthesis. **Equations must be typed with MS Word Equation editor.**
- SI units should be used, and notations should conform to standard norms.
- References cited in the text should follow the author-year convention and listed in alphabetical order at the end of the text.
- Authors should include a CD copy of their papers in Microsoft Word 2003 format. A copy should also be sent by e-mail to nsche2010@yahoo.com as an attachment.

Closing date for the receipt of all papers is **September 14, 2010**.
